What can go into the red textile bag?

Where do get my bag for the textiles

You can place textiles in the red bag. If you have not got a red bag you can [order here](#). Alternatively you can place items in a bag clearly marked for North Lincolnshire Council (we can't accept items presented in a charity bag).

Do the items need to be in good condition?

No as long as they are clean and dry, the items are graded by its condition and recycled accordingly.

How can I find out when my textile bag is collected?

Where do I present my textile bag for collection?

Please present your bag with your recycling boxes at the edge of your property where it meets the pavement by 7am on the day of collection.

I am unable to move my bins, boxes or bags out for collection. What can I do?

If you have a physical/medical condition/infirmity/a temporary injury/pregnancy leaving you unable to present your waste for collection, and there are no able bodied occupants at the property (over the age of 16), you can request an [assisted collection](#). Once approved you will receive an assisted collection for all bins, boxes and bags.
