A-B as indicated on the map: A 460-metre-long footpath commencing on the existing footpath at grid reference SE8795021482, proceeding across enclosures 185 and 192 in a southerly direction passing at its southern end through the grounds of Walcot Hall and to the east and south east of the said Hall to its junction with Burton Stather Road approximately 300 feet south east of the said Hall at grid reference SE8784921022.


