Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement

"Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 214, Appleby and Broughton) Order 2006(2)"

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming in to operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby - a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and the statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 1st August 2006.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the "Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 214, Appleby and Broughton) Order 2006 (2)".

SCHEDULE

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be added

A – B, as indicated on the map: A 693-metre-long footpath commencing on High Santon Road at grid reference SE9290011876 and proceeding along the disused railway line in a south-easterly direction to grid reference SE9341511457.

B - C, as indicated on the map: A 192-metre-long footpath commencing at grid reference SE9341511457 at a point just south of the disused railway line,

proceeding through a gravel strewn and denuded open area in a southerly direction, then turning eastwards through a wooded area to grid reference SE9350911376.

C – D, as indicated on the map: A 299-metre-long footpath commencing at the southern side of a wooded area at grid reference SE9350911376 and proceeding over an open area in a southerly direction to grid reference SE9348311073.

D – E, as indicated on the map: A 113-metre-long footpath commencing close to the south-western corner of an area of open scrubland and the western end of a grass track at grid reference SE9348311073 and proceeding along the grass track, through a wooded area, in an easterly direction to grid reference SE9359311106.

E – F, as indicated on the map: A 551-metre-long footpath commencing at the eastern end of a grass track and some 43 metres west of a wooded area at grid reference SE9359311106 and proceeding through an area of heathland, leading in a southerly direction into a wooded area along a grass track, to grid reference SE9367010555.

F – G, as indicated on the map: A 77-metre-long footpath commencing at grid reference SE9367010555 and proceeding along a grass track in a south-westerly direction, running along the northern side of a field, to grid reference SE9357910529.

G – H, as indicated on the map: A 277-metre-long footpath commencing at the south-western end of a grass track at grid reference SE9357910529 and proceeding along a farm track in a southerly direction to join the existing rubble footpath at the western end of a rubble farm track at grid reference SE9349410256.

The footpath has a width of 1.8 metres throughout.

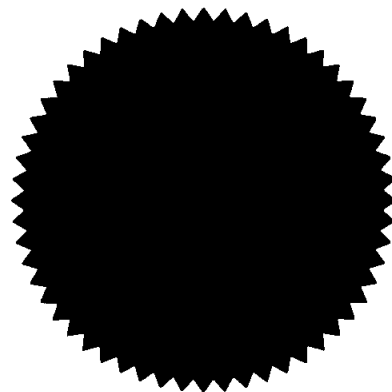

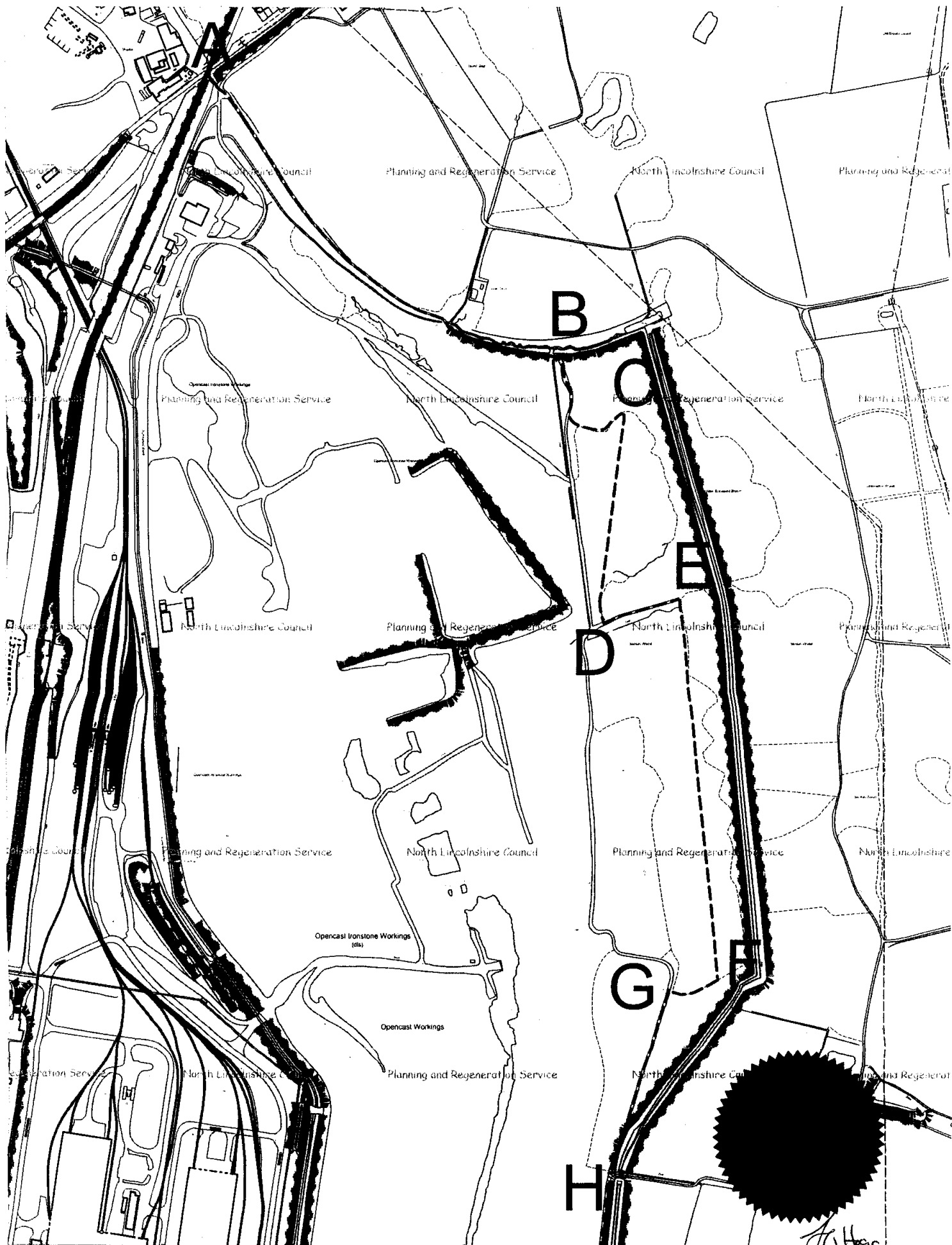
