"Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 39A, Barton-upon-Humber) Order 2006(1)"

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(iii) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a new right of way has been created over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path – of the Act.

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 13th February 2006.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the "Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 39A, Barton-upon-Humber) Order 2006(1)".

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path to be added

A – B, as indicated on the map: a 207-metre-long footpath of a width of four metres commencing at a point along the track known as Pasture Road North close to the entrance to Hoe Hill House at grid reference TA0402522950 and proceeding in an easterly direction to a point farther along Pasture Road North where it turns north at grid reference TA0423522957.

B – C, as indicated on the map: a 490-metre-long footpath of a width of four metres commencing at a point along the track known as Pasture Road North

where it turns from an easterly direction to a northerly one at grid reference TA0423522957 and proceeding in a northerly direction along the western bank of a lake to the foot, then up the slope, of the Humber bank to join Public Footpath 39 thereon at grid reference TA0418723445.



Variation of particulars of path

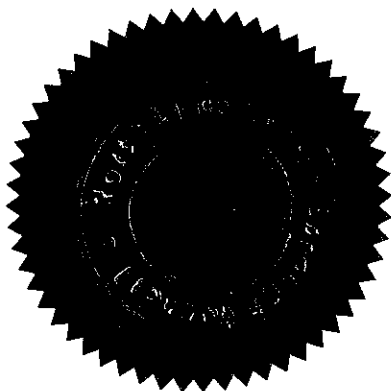
A 697-metre-long footpath of a width of four metres commencing at a point along the track known as Pasture Road North close to the entrance to Hoe Hill House at grid reference TA0402522950 and proceeding in an easterly direction to a point farther along Pasture Road North where it turns north at grid reference TA0423522957; and thence continuing in a northerly direction along the western bank of a lake to the foot, then up the slope, of the Humber bank to join Public Footpath 39 at grid reference TA0418723445.

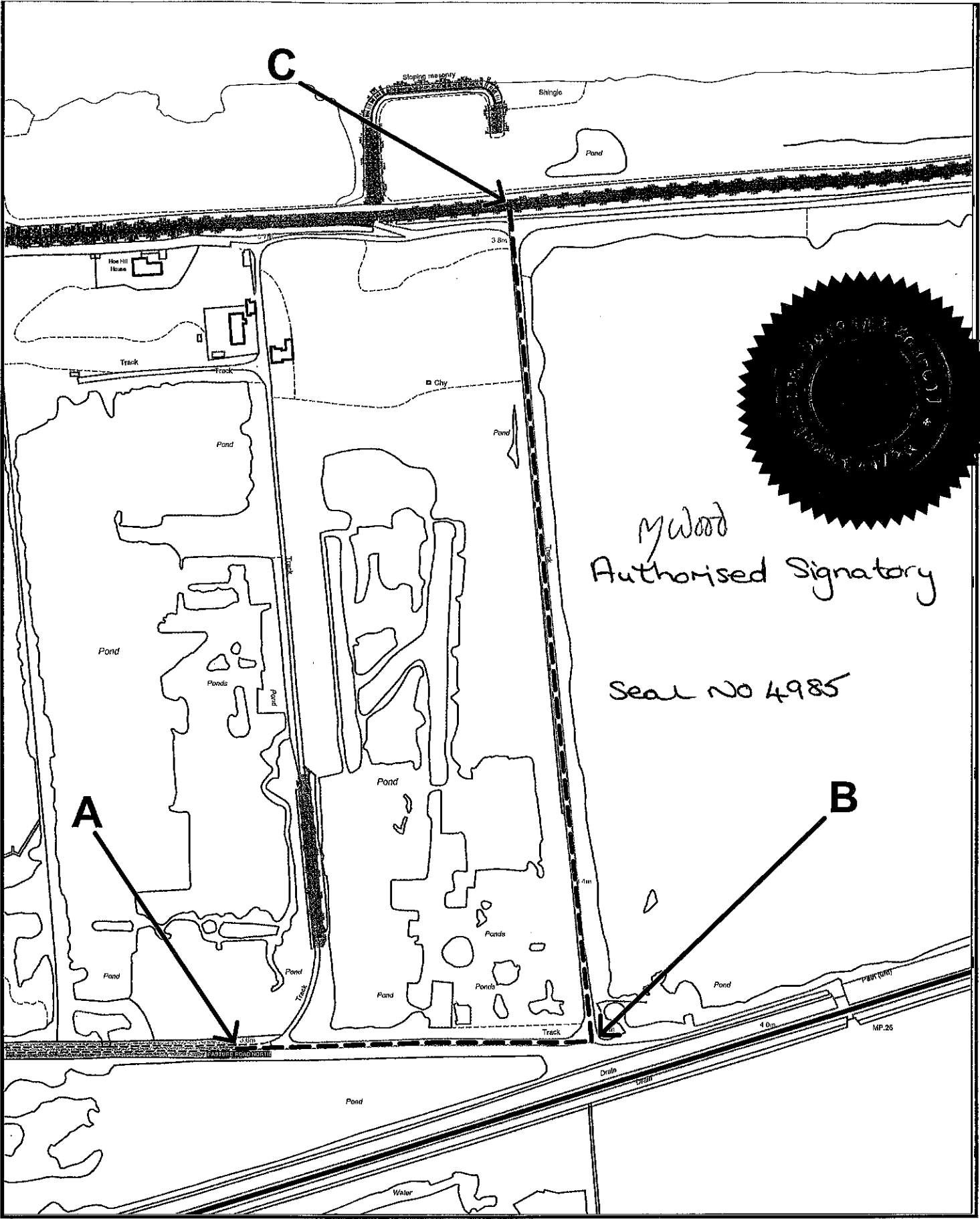
