Definitive Map Modification (Public Byway Open to All Traffic 21, Crowle) Order 2003(2)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the West Riding of Yorkshire Definitive Map and Statement (Thorne Rural District) require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) – namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way to which this Part applies – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 27th March 2003.
2. The West Riding of Yorkshire (Thorne Rural District) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part One and Part Two of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Byway Open to All Traffic 21, Crowle) Order 2003(2).

A 1,004-metre-long byway open to all traffic ^{having a width of 12.19 metres (40 feet)} ~~of a maximum width of 8 metres~~ over a well-defined track throughout leading in a north-easterly direction along the north-western edge of Crook O' Moor Drain from Point A (grid reference SE7472412279) immediately north of the Stainforth and Keadby Canal at the Medge Hall canal-and-railway crossing to Point B (grid reference SE7538813024) at its junction with the southernmost end of Yorkshire Moors Bottom Road as indicated on the map.

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars or way
having a width of 12.19 metres (40 feet)

A 1,004-metre-long byway open to all traffic of a ~~maximum width of 8 metres~~ over a well-defined track throughout leading in a north-easterly direction along the north-western edge of Crook O' Moor Drain from Point A (grid reference SE7472412279) immediately north of the Stainforth and Keadby Canal at the Medge Hall canal-and-railway crossing to Point B (grid reference SE7538813024) at its junction with the southernmost end of Yorkshire Moors Bottom Road as indicated on the map.
