Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 62, Goxhill) Order 2005(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a highway shown or required to be shown in the map or statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 27th March 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 62, Goxhill) Order 2005(1).

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

A -- B, as indicated on the map: a 147-metre-long footpath commencing at the junction of North End and Chapel Street at grid reference TA1026621669 and proceeding northwards in an easterly arc passing through several properties to grid reference TA1030821790.

C -- D, as indicated on the map: a 252-metre-long footpath commencing on North End approximately 40 metres north of the northern end of the southern section at grid reference TA1032021821 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction via gardens, the playing field and Goxhill Primary School to the north-western end of a "road used as a public path" called The Green Ramper at grid reference TA1044522032.

Description of path to be added

E -- F, as indicated on the map: a 85-metre-long footpath commencing on Chapel Street at grid reference TA1027621650 and proceeding along a wide track in a north-easterly direction to grid reference TA1034021708.

F -- G, as indicated on the map: a 34-metre-long footpath commencing at the north-eastern end of the aforementioned track at grid reference TA1034021708 and proceeding along the fenced boundary of Spring Garth in a north-westerly direction to grid reference TA1032121736.

G -- H, as indicated on the map: a 98-metre-long footpath commencing at the north-western corner of the field and to the rear of Sycamore House at grid reference TA1032121736 and proceeding to the rear of the fenced boundaries of four properties in a north-easterly direction to grid reference TA1039521800.

H -- I, as indicated on the map: a 83-metre-long footpath commencing in Goxhill Playing Field at grid reference TA1039521800 and proceeding along the boundary of the playing field in a north-westerly direction to the rear of Russel Lodge, Ashdene House and Thornton Lodge to grid reference TA1034921870.

I -- J, as indicated on the map: a 49-metre-long footpath commencing in the north-western corner of the playing field at grid reference TA1034921870 and proceeding along the boundary of the play area in a north-easterly direction to grid reference TA1038921897.

J -- K, as indicated on the map: a 89-metre-long footpath continuing along the boundary of the play area at grid reference TA1038921897 and proceeding in a north-westerly direction over the playing field before crossing a tarmac section of path to the east of The Bungalow to join North End and the entrance to Goxhill Playing Field at grid reference TA1033421964. The path shall have a minimum width of 1.8 metres.

PART 2

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Variation of particulars of path

An 85-metre-long footpath commencing on Chapel Street at grid reference TA1027621650 and proceeding along a wide track in a north-easterly direction to the end of the track at grid reference TA1034021708, then proceeding for 34 metres along the fenced boundary of Spring Garth in a north-westerly direction to the north-western corner of the field and to the rear of Sycamore House grid reference TA1032121736, and then proceeding for 98 metres in a north-easterly direction at the rear of the fenced boundaries of four properties to Goxhill Playing Field at grid reference TA1039521800, then for 83 metres along the boundary of the playing field in a north-westerly direction at the rear of Russel Lodge, Ashdene House and Thornton Lodge to the north-western corner of the playing field grid reference TA1034921870, then for 49 metres along the boundary of the play area in a north-easterly direction to grid reference TA1038921897, and continuing for 89 metres along the boundary of the play area in a north-westerly direction over the playing field before crossing a tarmac section of path to the east of The Bungalow to join North End and the entrance to Goxhill Playing Field at grid reference TA1033421964. The path has a minimum width of 1.8 metres throughout.

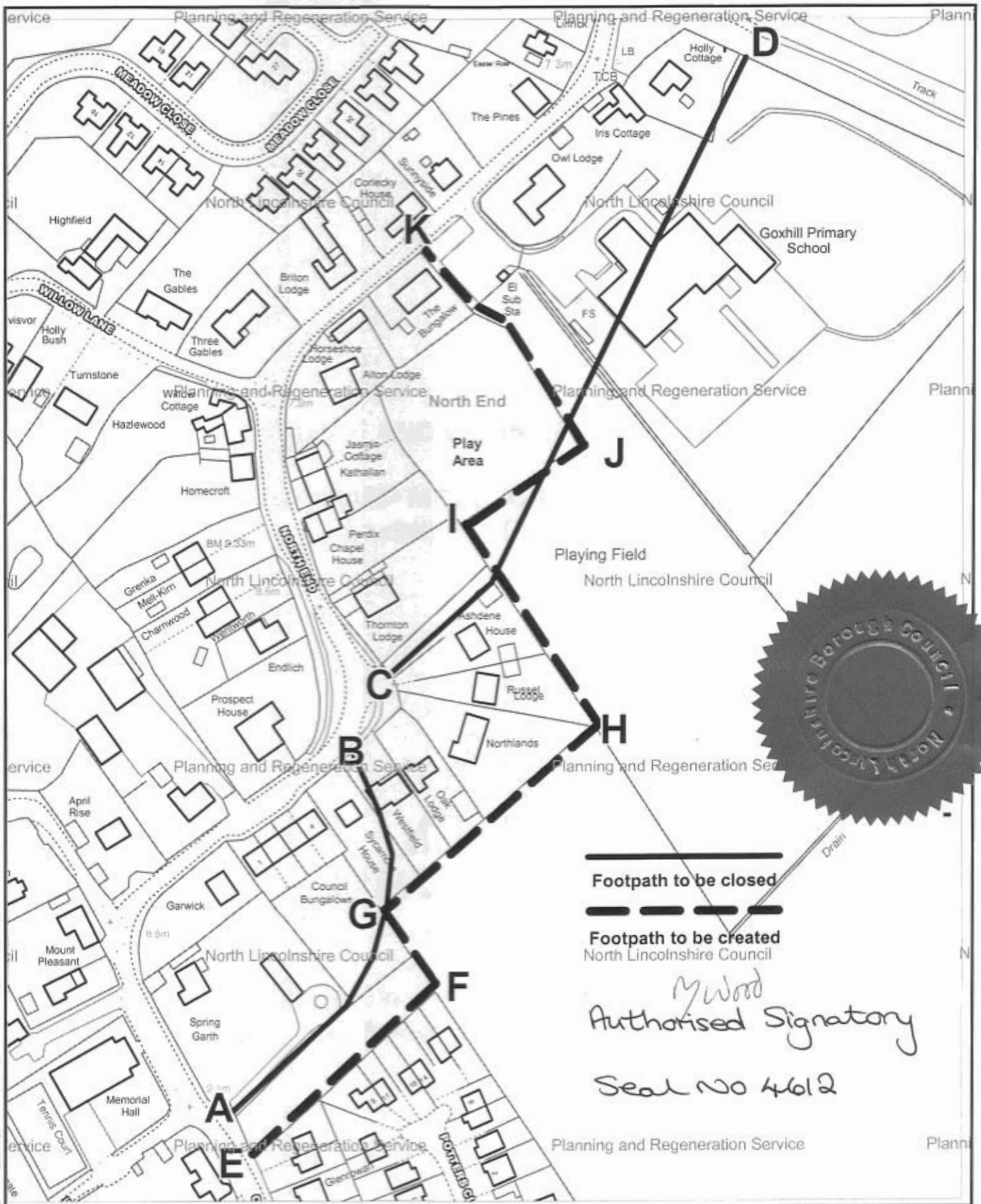
