Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 334, Hibaldstow) Order 2005(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a highway shown or required to be shown in the map or statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 25 February 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 334, Hibaldstow) Order 2005(1).

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

A – B as indicated on the plan: A 58-metre-long section of footpath commencing on Beck Side at grid reference SE9777102720, that runs diagonally through West End farmyard in a south-easterly direction to the southern boundary of the farmyard at grid reference SE9779602669.



Description of path to be added

D – C, as indicated on the map: A 44-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.2 metres commencing on Beck Side some 42 metres east of the original point at grid reference SE9780602724, proceeding along the eastern side of a boundary wall belonging to a property known as No. 4 Beck Side and the western boundary fence of properties known as No. 6 and No. 8 Beck Side in a southerly direction to grid reference SE9781302681.

C – B, as indicated on the map: A 21-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.2 metres commencing at the south-west boundary fence of a property known as No. 6 Beck Side at grid reference SE9781302681, proceeding along the southern boundary wall of a property known as No 4 Beck Side and the northern side of a drain in a south-westerly direction to a footbridge at grid reference SE9779602669.


Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Variation of particulars of path

A 65-metre-long footpath commencing on Beck Side at grid reference SE9780602724, proceeding along the eastern boundary wall belonging to a property known as No. 4 Beck Side and the western boundary fence of properties known as No. 6 and No. 8 Beck Side in a southerly direction to the south-west boundary of No. 6 Beck Side to grid reference SE9781302681, and then along the southern boundary wall of a property known as No.4 Beck Side and the northern side of a drain in a south-west direction to a concrete footbridge and the existing public footpath at grid reference SE9781302681. The footpath has a minimum width of 1.2 metres throughout.

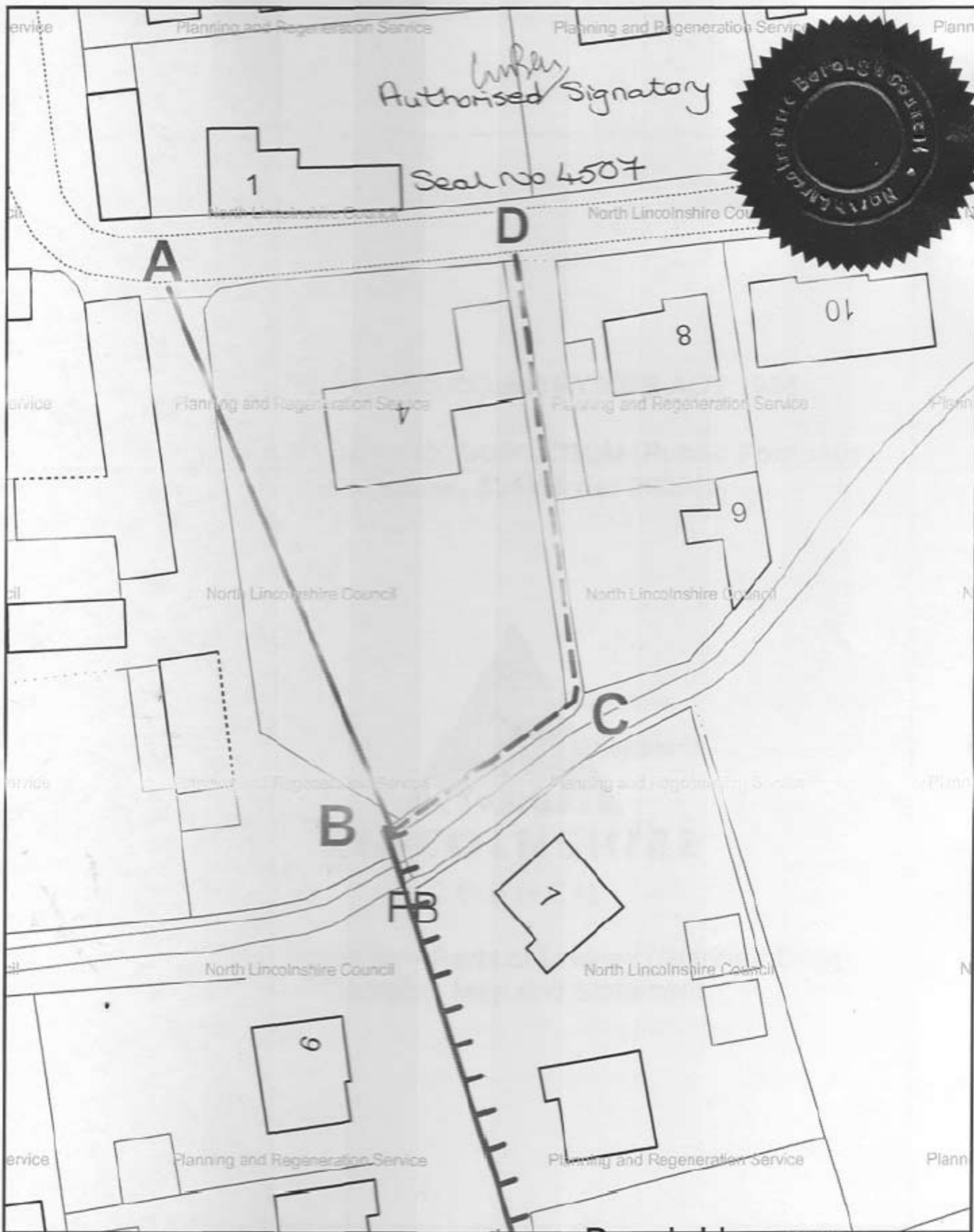
