Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 248, Kirton-in-Lindsey) Order 2005(2)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a highway shown or required to be shown in the map or statement has been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 25 February 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 248, Kirton-in-Lindsey) Order 2005(2).

PART 1

Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map

Description of path to be deleted

A – B, as indicated on the map: A 78-metre-long footpath commencing midway along the existing footpath at the south-west corner of a field at grid reference



SK9354499661, and following the western boundary of a field in a north-north-westerly direction to grid reference SK9354999637.

B – C, as indicated on the map: A 45-metre-long footpath commencing at grid reference SK9352699735, and proceeding in a north-easterly direction to the western tip of a field to grid reference SK9357099780.

Description of path to be added

A – C, as indicated on the map: A 103-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.5 metres commencing midway along the existing footpath at the south-west corner of a field at grid reference SK9354999637, and proceeding in a north-north-easterly direction to the western tip of a field to grid reference SK9357099780.


Modification of Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars of path

A 103-metre-long footpath with a width of 1.5 metres commencing midway along the existing footpath at the south-west corner of a field at grid reference SK9354999637, and proceeding over a stile and following the eastern side of a fence belonging to a property known as Station Farm, in a north-north-easterly direction to a stile at the western tip of a field to grid reference SK9357099780.

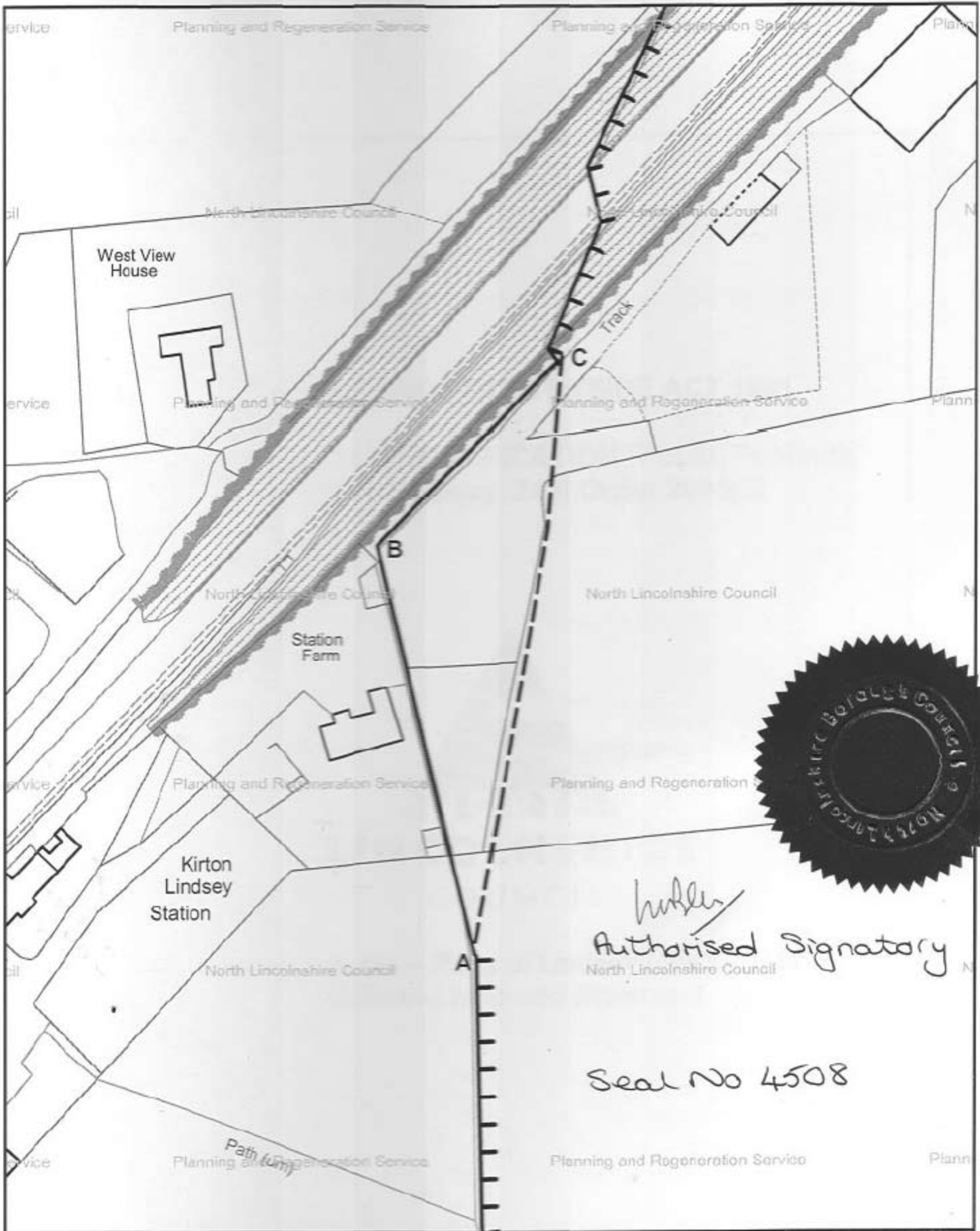
