## **Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981**

### **County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement**

#### **"Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 6, West Halton) Order 2005(2)"**

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(a) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(iii) – namely, the coming into operation of any enactment or instrument, or any other event, whereby a new right of way has been created over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path – of the Act.

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 14<sup>th</sup> November 2005.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the "Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 6, West Halton) Order 2005(2)".

#### **SCHEDULE**

##### **PART 1**

##### **Modification of Definitive Map**

##### *Description of path or way to be added*

*A – B, as indicated on the map:* An approximately 840-metre-long footpath of a width of 1.2 metres commencing at a point on the eastern side of Whitton Road approximately 870 metres north of the property known as The Elms at grid reference SE9036522086 and proceeding in an easterly direction along the northern side of a drain to a point close to where that drain meets a north-to-south drain at grid reference SE9118422241.

**B – C, as indicated on the map:** an approximately 10-metre-long footpath of a width of 1.2 metres commencing close to where the east-to-west drain from Whitton Road meets a north-to-south drain, this being at grid reference SE9118422241 and proceeding in a southerly direction along the western side of the north-to-south drain to a point at grid reference SE9118822232.

PART 2

Modification of Definitive Statement

*Variation of particulars of path*

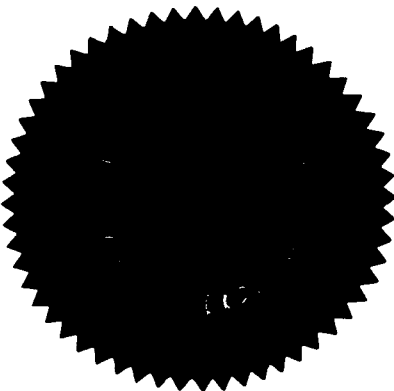
A 1.2-metre-wide footpath proceeding first in an easterly direction for 840 metres along the northern side of an east-to-west drain from a point on Whitton Road at grid reference SE9036522086 to a point at grid reference SE91 18422241 close to where the east-to-west drain meets a north-to-south drain; thence continuing in a southerly direction for ten metres along the western side of a north-to-south drain to a point at grid reference SE9118822232.

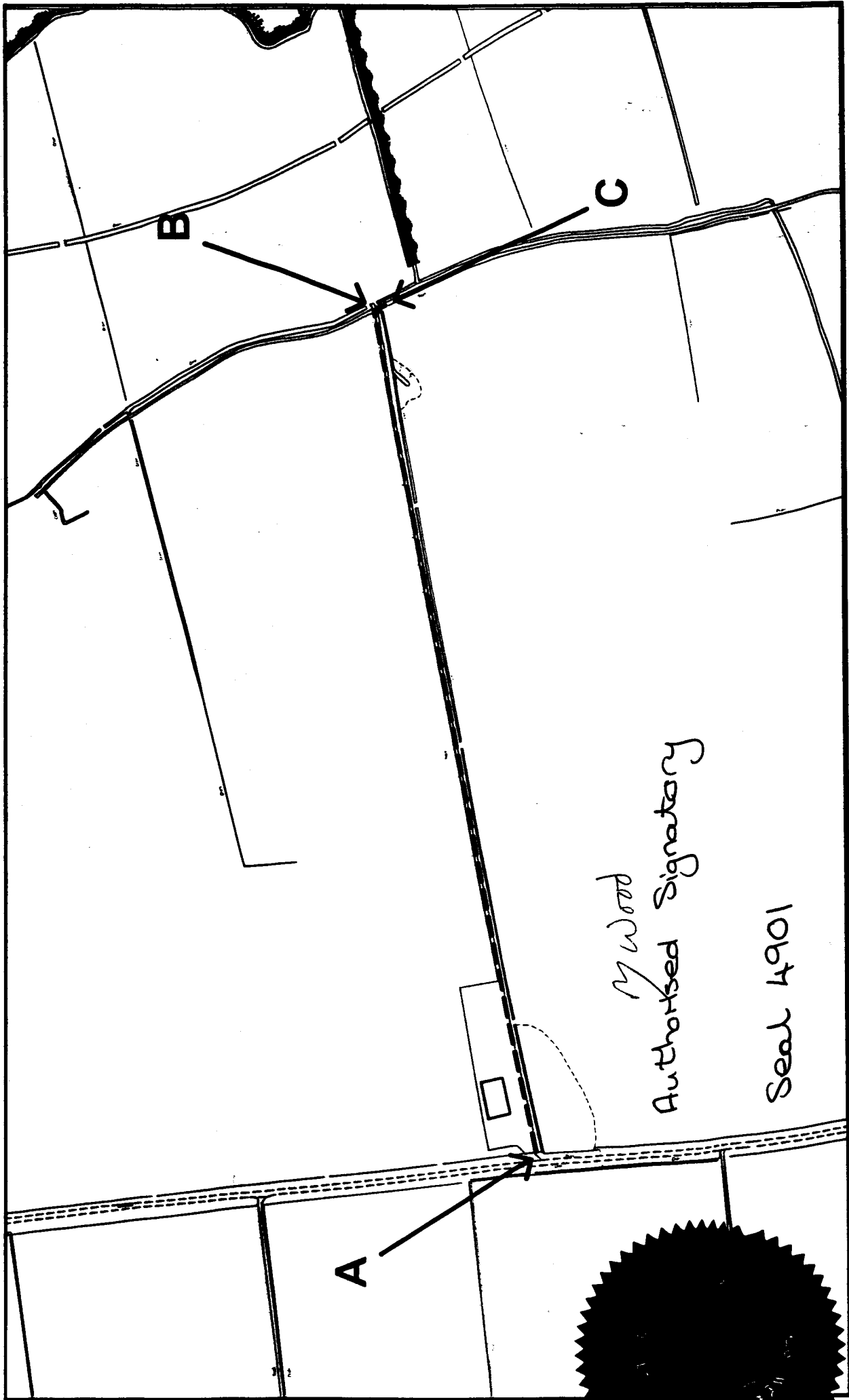
