County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement

Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 46, New Holland) Order 2004(1)

This order is made by North Lincolnshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(iii) – namely, a new right of way has been created over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path – of the Act.

The authority have consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. North Lincolnshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this order the relevant date is 1st September 2004.
2. The County of Lincoln – Parts of Lindsey (Glanford Brigg) Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date it is made and may be cited as the Definitive Map Modification (Public Footpath 46, New Holland) Order 2004.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path to be added

Point A – B: a 1.2 metre wide, 15-metre-long section of footpath commencing at Public Footpath 45, grid reference TA0808423952, and proceeding in an easterly direction between a post and rail fence to the north and a steel barrier to the south to grid reference TA0810423954.

Point B – C: an 83-metre-long section of footpath surfaced to a width of 1.2 metres within a 17-metre width of public open space commencing at grid reference TA0810423954 and curving in an easterly, then north-easterly then northerly direction to rejoin Lincoln Castle Way at grid reference TA0816323974.

Limitations and Conditions

The footpath proceeds through a steel squeeze barrier before gaining access to the continuation of the footpath at grid reference TA0810423954, Point B. At grid reference TA0816323974 Point C, there are two steel barriers adjacent to the pavement.

PART 2

Modification of Definitive Statement

Variation of particulars of path or way

A 98-metre-long footpath commencing at its junction with Public Footpath 45, grid reference TA0808423952, then proceeding for 15 metres in an easterly direction at 1.2 metres wide between a post and rail fence to the north and a steel barrier to the south to a steel squeeze barrier at grid reference TA0810423954, whereupon the path curves in a first south – easterly, then easterly, then north-easterly, then a northerly direction for 83 metres to rejoin Lincoln Castle Way at a steel squeeze barrier at grid reference TA0816323974. The footpath is surfaced to a width of 1.2 metres within a 17-metre width of public open space.

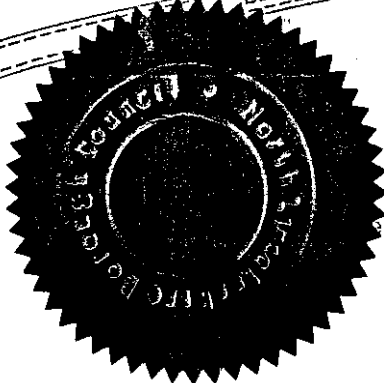
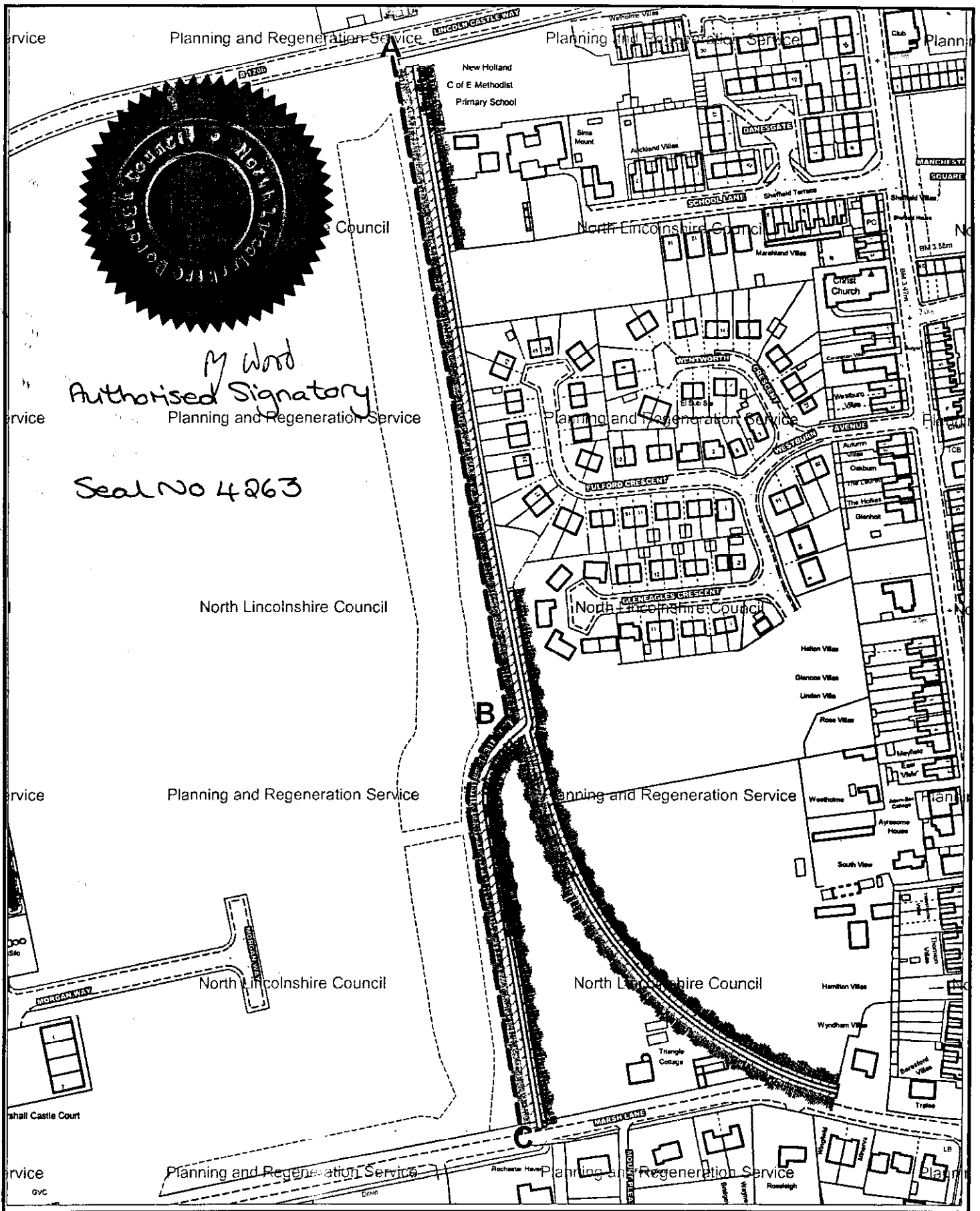
